WHAT IS A LEGAL TRANSCRIP-TIONIST?

The Legal Transcriptionist Training Program teaches basic legal transcription skills to candidates wishing to type depositions and other legal proceedings from audio recordings.

The recordings are typically made by a videographer without a court reporter present.

Legal transcripts must be totally accurate and verbatim for use in court proceedings.

A successful program candidate will have good hearing and typing skills.

A foot pedal is used to facilitate audio playback, along with good-quality headphones.

HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAM?

The Nonmedical Transcription Program consists of academic and skills lessons that can be completed within 30 days. The program is self-paced, with a maximum length of 60 days.
